This Site was developed by TapTools, as part of a funded engagement with the Cardano Builder DAO. Its primary purpose is to present a unified dashboard displaying Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) submitted by individual projects as part of their DAO funding applications.

The Site aggregates self-reported KPIs and supporting data from participating projects to improve transparency, accountability, and ecosystem visibility. It serves as a public resource for the Cardano Builder DAO and the broader Cardano community to track and evaluate project outcomes over time.
